



Meniffee County Schools

In-Person Instruction:

- All in-person instruction will take place at Meniffee Elementary and Meniffee County High School.
- Students who selected in-person instruction will return on a staggered schedule which is shared below.
- Students will attend in-person classes 2-days a week either on a Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday rotation. Rotation assignments were determined for bus riders based on geographical location and bus routes. Students will learn virtually for the rest of the week. Rotation assignments can be found in your student's Google Classroom, no later than noon on Friday the 25th.
- The school day will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 3:30 p.m. Students can not be dropped off at the buildings prior to 7:35 a.m.
- Temperature checks will take place prior to students loading the bus or exiting a vehicle for drop-off by school staff. Parents should complete temperature checks as well. Any student with a temperature of 100.4 and/or any other Co-Vid 19 related symptoms should remain at home. They will not be allowed on campus based on Kentucky Public Health Guidelines.
- Students will be required to wear masks both in the classrooms and on the bus.
 - Kindergarten students will wear masks on the bus, but will not be required to wear a mask during class according to Kentucky Health Guidelines
- Social distancing guidelines (six-feet apart) will be followed.
 - Classrooms have been set up to meet social distancing guidelines, with no more than 11-12 students in a standard classroom.
 - Transitions will be limited to student learning groups within one classroom.
- Due to social distancing guidelines, no parent will be allowed to accompany students into the buildings.
- All students will continue with virtual learning classes on Fridays.
- Students who are not riding the bus can not be picked up prior to busses leaving the parking lot after 3:45.
- Below is the schedule for our staggered return to in-person classes.

September 28th	Grades K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 9 th and 12th
October 5th	Add Grade 11- Continue with grades K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 9 th and 12th

October 12th

Add grades 6th, 7th, 8th, and 10th. At this time ALL students who selected in-person will return on their designated Monday/Tuesday or Wednesday/Thursday schedule.

Virtual Instruction:

- Botts Elementary will serve as the “virtual campus” for K-5 students, as well as students who may require additional virtual learning and other educational needs.
- Students who selected virtual instruction will continue to learn at home with the support of their grade level and content teachers.
- Through appointment times, students will be able to work with teachers in small groups or 1:1 sessions on campus.
- Changes from virtual to in-person learning will be made at the end of the first semester (Christmas Break). Expectations can be made based on principal approval and will be reviewed individually.
- All students will continue with virtual learning classes on Fridays.

Additional Information:

Students who select virtual learning will be eligible to receive 5 meals, delivered by bus or for pick up at Botts Elementary or Menifee County High School on Fridays. Students who select in-person will be eligible to receive 3 meals, in the same manner. These sites will not be opened Monday through Thursday.
